Communication and Language

This week we will be reading the following stories:

This week's key vocabulary

spider, web, legs, silk, spin, kind, sad, up, down

Physical Development

This week we will be supporting the children to find a comfortable grip when holding a pencil or pen.

Encourage your child to explore with drawing and mark making.

Can they draw a spider web and spider?

Literacy

Encourage your child to sing the nursery rhyme Incy Wincy Spider

Phonics

Exploring with sounds – using everyday objects at home encourage your child to explore sounds (pots, pans, spoons etc, rice in a bottle etc.)

Maths

Counting – encourage your child to count in sequence to 10.

Topic

Can you find out some fun spider facts together?

You could go on a spider web hunt. Where do spiders like to make webs?
