We will share photos and art work with the children and talk to them about how proud we are of their efforts. This could be anything from sharing a toy to painting their firework picture. We will also be reinforcing our behaviour ladder. The children all have their photo on the green level. If the children try their best, make a series of good choices or exceed our expectations they will be moved up to the gold level. Each week children who have been moved to gold could be selected to receive our Nursery certificate. Phonics


