An adult will play alongside the children supporting and modelling how they can join in with each other plays, use talk through play and share and take turns.  We will also talk about how three bears in the story are a family. We will look at photographs of different families and talk about our own families. Our focus will be on pedalling and steering the trikes. The children have road and arrows to follow. We will be talking about direction and travelling in the same direction as others.
