




# Early Years Home Learning

<p>Hear your child read their reading books. Make a comment in the Reading Log to let the class teacher know how they responded to the reading. Remember to read books on Bug Club...your log in is attached to your reading log. It is good to reread books to support your child's fluency and confidence with reading.</p>	<p>Take opportunities to have fun with maths. When going for a walk take opportunities to look for numbers in the environment, for example on houses, on cars, on buses, on road signs, in shops etc.</p> <p>Support your child to understand that there are numbers everywhere and that they have a meaning.</p>	<p>Spend some fun time together using junk modelling/art materials from around the home to create a snowman.
