This week our topic is: Settling into Reception.

We will be introduced to Jigsaw Jennie, who will help us take turns to listen to others and give us a turn to talk. We will be learning about belonging and how we now belong to a class and to Alexandra Primary School.	This week the children will focus on learning about rhyming words. I wonder why you need to wash your hands at school?

Homework:

It is important to hear your child read every day.
