<p>The children will be given opportunities to talk about their visit to their Year 1 class. They will have the opportunity to talk about what they are looking forward to and/or any worries.</p> 	<p>During the course of this week's learning we will be encouraging your child to share and explain their ideas and articulate by speaking using sentences.</p> 	<p>The children will have opportunities to practise their fine motor skills using different resources in the environment and through handwriting practice.</p> 
Literacy	Maths	Time to Talk
<p>The children will be blending and segmenting sounds to read and write sentences and words. The children will be encouraged to engage with books independently.</p>	<p>In maths, we will be recapping and consolidating the understanding of many of the concepts learnt this year. We will be doing this through games.</p> 	<p><i>You may ask your child what they have done in Reception and they may be unable to tell you. By asking them a more specific question, it will support them to respond. Each week we will offer a suggestion of a topic to talk about with your child. Please encourage your child to talk to you using sentences.</i></p> <p>Ask your child: What are you looking forward to when you are in Year 1.</p>
Phonics		
<p>The focus for phonics this week is to recap the sounds and tricky words taught to date. The children will also practise reading and writing a range of words reinforcing the sounds that have already been taught.</p>
